Description

In this course, students will learn about different varieties of English, concentrating on regional varieties spoken on the British Isles. We will discuss distinctive linguistic features (phonological, morphological, syntactic, semantic, pragmatic) of a number of regional dialects. These varieties of English will also be embedded in a broader context by discussing how they emerged historically. Moreover, we will reflect on theoretical frameworks and research methods applied in the field of (regional) variation.
